Guerin College Prep Open House to feature an Escape Room Challenge

River Grove: On Wednesday, April 25, Guerin Prep will be hosting an open house for 6th and 7th grade students and their families. The event, which will give parents an opportunity to tour the school and learn about Guerin Prep's many offerings, will also feature an Escape Room Challenge for the students. With two sessions planned (at 6pm and 7pm) participants will receive a "mission" that must be accomplished within a certain amount of time. This is the first time the school has incorporated an event like this into their open house.

Admissions Director Tony Pecoraro said that his team was anxious to try something new. "We are hoping that this event will draw interested students and their families to Guerin because of the opportunity to do something different," said Pecoraro.

In addition to the Escape Room Challenge, parents will have the opportunity to meet with the school principal, get information on academics, the three levels of learning the school provides, preparation for college, the new High School Placement Test (HSPT), athletic and extracurricular activities, and much more. Students and parents will meet up at the end of the session to "debrief" with each other.
