GUERIN PREP SENIOR ANTHONY ALLEGRETTI RECEIVES CHICK EVANS CADDIE SCHOLARSHIP

Anthony Allegretti, a senior at Guerin Prep High School and an Elmwood Park resident, has been named a Chick Evans Caddie Scholarship recipient. He will attend Marquette University (Milwaukee, Wisc.) in the fall.

The scholarship is a one-year grant which covers tuition and housing and may be renewed for up to four years. Finalists for the award, who are nominated by the golf clubs for which they caddie, must rank in the upper quarter of their class, have above a B average in college preparatory classes, clearly establish their need for financial assistance and be outstanding in character, integrity and leadership

Anthony caddies for the Oak Park Country Club and has been a member of Guerin Prep's golf team. A member of the National Honor Society, Anthony has been a class officer the past three years, serving last year as the junior class president and this year as the secretary of the senior class. He is the founder of the debate club at Guerin Prep. Additionally, he serves as an Ambassador for the school.

Anthony plans to major in political science at Marquette and eventually hopes to earn a law degree. His long-term goal is a life of politics. He will continue to caddy at the Oak Park Country Club while attending college.

A graduate of St. Cyprian Elementary School, Anthony is the son of Michael and Paula Jo Allegretti.

Anthony said his family was elated when they learned that he had been awarded the scholarship. "This is such a blessing," he said.

2—Allegretti Earns Evans Scholarship

Founded by golf great Charles "Chick" Evans, Jr., the Evans Scholarship is now administered by the Western Golf Association. Applicants must have caddied for a minimum of two years at a WGA affiliated club.

More than 840 Evans Scholars are currently attending college at 19 universities. Alumni graduates now total over 8,700. Almost all Evans Scholars attend one of the 14 universities where the Foundation maintains a Scholarship House. An Evans Scholar is asked to fulfill four requirements: They must maintain a strong academic record, be actively involved in house and campus affairs, respect their fellow Scholars and faithfully perform assigned house maintenance duties.
