Today, the average cost of educating a Guerin Prep student exceeds \$10,000; through our continual fund raising efforts, we are able to offer this year's tuition equal to last year.

### SCHOLARSHIPS AND FINANCIAL AID

Guerin Prep offers various scholarships and financial assistance throughout the student's education. Please review the information on pages 11 and 12 for application requirements and deadlines. Updated information is available on our website.

Financial aid applications are offered to all current and incoming families. Applications are available in English and Spanish.

\*All tuition and fees must be paid through our partner, Tuition Management Systems (TMS).

Three plans are available:

- 1) One payment in full on or before 7/15/10 (\$250 discount applies; enrollment fee waived)
- 2) Four quarterly payments due on or before 7/15/10, 10/15/10, 1/15/11 and 4/15/11, or
- 3) Ten monthly payments due on or before the 15th of each month beginning July '10 and ending April '11.

## PROCEDURES AND IMPORTANT DATES CHECKLIST

To be considered for scholarships and financial aid from Guerin Prep, incoming freshmen must take the entrance exam at Guerin Prep.

- Jan. 6, 2011: **Current students** pick up Private School Aid Services (PSAS), Guerin Prep Financial Aid Information Sheet and scholarship specific applications from the Guerin Prep Business Office or download them online at [www.guerinprep.org](http://www.guerinprep.org). Applications are available in English and Spanish.
- Jan. 8, 2011: **Incoming freshmen** take the Guerin Prep Entrance Exam to be considered for any financial assistance and receive financial aid applications.
- By Jan. 31, 2011: **Incoming freshmen and current students** must complete the Private School Aid Service application and submit the PSAS application, 2009 1040, 2009 W-2 and \$21 fee to PSAS, our outside processing partner. (Do NOT return the PSAS application and fee to Guerin Prep).
- By Jan. 31, 2011: **Incoming freshmen and current students** must also complete the Guerin Prep Financial Aid Information Sheet. Return this form to the Guerin Prep business office.
- March 2011: Guerin Prep sends announcements of financial aid. Any financial aid awarded following these announcements will depend on the circumstances of the request and the availability of funds.
- NOTE: Certain scholarships have additional applications with specific requirements and deadlines. Please read the applications carefully to ensure you meet all requirements on time.

## OTHER TYPES OF TUITION ASSISTANCE

### GUERIN PREP TUITION INSURANCE

The tuition obligation of a current student enrolled at Guerin Prep will be assumed by the high school at the death of the designated parent(s) or the designated legal guardian(s) responsible for tuition payments. Included in the “General Fees” is a \$50 fee to cover parents or guardians. Only those parents or guardians designated as responsible for paying tuition on the registration form are eligible. The benefit takes effect on the date the next tuition payment is due for the student following the death of the parent/guardian responsible for the tuition payment.

### PARENTAL LOANS

The Guerin Prep vice president for financial affairs can direct parents to specific loan programs available for private secondary education or you can inquire at your financial institutions.

### TUITION TAX CREDIT

Families can also apply for a state income tax credit of up to \$500 per family through filing of an annual income tax return. Please contact your tax professional for details and qualifications.

### STUDENT WORK PROGRAM

Guerin Prep employs a limited number of students; a waiting list is maintained after initial positions have been filled. Registered students may apply at the business office.
