



GUERIN COLLEGE PREPARATORY HIGH SCHOOL (GCP) PHYSICAL EXAMINATION AND IMMUNIZATION REQUIREMENTS

A student entering or enrolled in GCP High School is required to have on file proof of a physical exam and proof of the appropriate immunization as required by state law and the Illinois Department of Public Health.

Procedures: In compliance with Illinois School Code (Chapter 122, para 27-8.1) and the rules and regulations of the Illinois Department of Public Health for immunization (Statutory Authority, Chapter 111-1/2, par. 11.11 and 11.12, Illinois Revised Statutes, 1977), the following procedures will be required of all students:

1. Students entering the ninth grade and transfer students must submit proof of a physical examination with required immunizations. Proof of this physical examination and immunization record must be submitted on the required state form. The physical examination for ninth graders must have been completed within one year prior to the first day of school.**

STUDENTS WILL BE EXCLUDED FROM SCHOOL IF PHYSICAL EXAM AND IMMUNIZATION RECORDS ARE NOT SUBMITTED BY THE FIRST OF OCTOBER. Senate Bill 1215 permits transfer student 15 days to produce school records including physical examination and immunization records from their former school. Under no circumstances will these students be permitted to participate in physical activities including physical education classes and athletics until all required records are obtained. This will be considered an excused absence and the student will have the opportunity and responsibility to make up the excused absences.

2. When indicated, students must submit an updated immunization record in compliance with the above mentioned statutes for continued enrollment.
3. Students who are enrolled will be notified in writing at least 30 days prior to the date when the student's immunization booster shots no longer meet state guidelines.

4. If a student fails to comply by the required dates for updating immunizations, then the local school authority shall exclude the student from school until such time the student presents proof of having received needed immunizations.

**Person(s) having custody or control over the student who is excluded under Section 27-8.1 is subject to criminal prosecution for a Class C Misdemeanor under Section 26-10 of the Illinois School Code, punishable by 30 day's imprisonment and/or a fine of up to \$500.
