



## STATE AND ILLINOIS SCHOOL CODE MANDATED IMMUNIZATIONS

**DIPHTHERIA - PERTUSSIS-TETANUS (DPT or DTaP):** Must have received 3 or more doses of DPT DTaP or Td with the last dose being received on or after the 4th birthday.

**DIPHTHERIA-TETANUS (Td):** Booster must have been received within the past 8-10 years.

**POLIOMYELITIS (OPV, IPV):** Must have 3 or more doses I/OPV with the last dose qualifying as a booster and received on or after the 4th birthday.

**MEASLES - Red, Hard or Two Week (Rubeola):** Must have received two doses of live measles virus vaccine, with the first dose administered after 12 months of age and the second dose separated by a minimum of 4 weeks, or had physician diagnosed measles disease or laboratory evidence of immunity.

**RUBELLA (German or 3 day):** Must have received vaccine after 12 months of age. Proof of disease by physician documentation IS NOT ACCEPTABLE. Adequate antibody titer is acceptable proof of disease.

**MUMPS:** Must have received vaccine after 12 months of age. Immunization is not necessary if disease is confirmed by a physician's signature. Adequate antibody titer is acceptable proof of disease.

**HEPATITIS B:** Since 2002, all students have been required to have 3 doses of the vaccine at the recommended intervals.

**DIABETES SCREENING:** Beginning with the Class of 2010, incoming freshmen must show that they have gone through a screening test for diabetes.
