## FRESHMAN EXPERIENCE

Recognizing the need to support academically challenged students with a more structured program, Guerin College Prep High School offers The Sullivan Program. The student is required to complete the Freshman Experience during the summer prior to his/her freshman year and is then admitted into the Sullivan Program if needed.

The summer courses offered in this program are designed and taught by members of the Guerin Prep faculty and are intended to strengthen students' academic skills and prepare them for success in high school.

Participation is by invitation only and is mandatory for students with conditional acceptance.

The **LANGUAGE ARTS PROGRAM** is designed for those students who scored below grade level on the entrance exam and will be taking Freshman English in the fall. This course will introduce and reinforce basic writing, reading and language arts skills.

The **MATH PROGRAM** is designed for those students who scored below grade level on the entrance exam and will be taking Pre-Algebra in the fall. This course will consist of a review of basic computational skills, including the addition, subtraction, multiplication and division of whole numbers, fractions and decimals.
